Social Media Campaign Against Violence

In the latter part of 2023, the club launched a robust social media campaign against violence. The club released thought-provoking and powerful public service announcements (PSAs) across various social media platforms. These PSAs were aimed at raising awareness, sparking conversations, and encouraging collective action against all forms of violence.

Webinar on Child and Mental Health

Recognizing the importance of mental health, especially for our youth, the Zonta Club of New Providence hosted a timely and informative webinar focused on "Your Child and Mental Health." This event aimed to equip teachers, aunts, grandparents, youth leaders, and anyone involved in the well-being of children with valuable insights on what to look out for and how to provide support. Presenters were Psychological Counselor Kavita Garikaparthi and members of the Royal Bahamas Police Force, School Policing division. Topics covered included:

- Identifying signs of mental health challenges in children.
- Strategies for promoting positive mental health.
- Resources available for seeking help and support.

Collaboration with the Salvation Army

In the spirit of community service and collaboration, the Zonta Club of New Providence proudly partnered with the Salvation Army for a Christmas Good Turn.
